## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend the salary structure of employees of the Sokehs Municipal Government by transferring the Cost of Living Allowance (COLA) of \$80.00 into the base salary, and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE SOKEHS MUNICIPAL COUNCIL:

41 -- 4 Cl- -- 4 TE41-

1	Section 1. Short Title.
2	This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "COLA Transfer to Base
3	Salary Act of 2025."
4	Section 2. Purpose.
5	The purpose of this Act is to adjust the compensation structure of Sokehs
6	Municipal Government employees by incorporating the current Cost of Living
7	Allowance (COLA) of eighty dollars (\$80.00) into the base salary. This adjustment
8	is aimed at ensuring more transparency and fairness in employee compensation and
9	streamlining the payroll process.
10	Section 3. Definitions.
11	For purposes of this Act, the following terms shall have the meanings
12	specified:
13	(a) "Cost of Living Allowance (COLA)" refers to the additional
14	compensation provided to employees to offset increases in the cost of living.
15	(b) "Base Salary" refers to the standard salary provided to
16	employees before additional allowances or benefits.
17	Section 4. COLA Transfer to Base Salary.
18	Effective immediately upon the enactment of this Act:
19	(a) The current Cost of Living Allowance (COLA) of eighty dollars
20	(\$80.00) by weekly shall be permanently transferred and added to the base salary of
21	all eligible employees and contractual services of the Sokehs Municipal
22	Government.
23	(b) The new base salary for all eligible employees shall reflect this

1	adjustment and shall be applied uniformly across all pay scales.	
2	Section 5. No Reduction in Total Compensation.	
3	No employee of the Sokehs Municipal Government shall experience a	
4	reduction in their total compensation as a result of this Act. The total compensation,	
5	including all allowances, shall be at least equal to the previous total compensation	
6	before this Act.	
7	Section 6. Implementation and Compliance.	
8	(a) The Chief Magistrate of Sokehs shall ensure that the provisions of this	
9	Act are implemented and reflected in the payroll records of all municipal	
10	employees.	
11	(b) The Office of Human Resources shall be responsible for recalculating	
12	the base salaries of all affected employees and ensuring compliance with this Act.	
13	Section 7. Repealer Clause.	
14	Any existing laws, rules, regulations, or executive orders that are	
15	inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or amended to conform to the	
16	provisions herein.	
17	Section 8. Effective Date.	
18	This Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the Chief	
19	Magistrate of Sokehs and the Sokehs Municipal Council.
